#### Fried Cod Dinner \$16

Three pieces of fried battered cod fish. Served with Jo-Jo wedge potatoes, homemade hot sauce rice, tangy vinegar coleslaw, and tartar sauce.

#### Baked Cod Dinner \$16

Two pieces of cod fish. Served with green beans, homemade hot sauce rice, tangy vinegar coleslaw, and tartar sauce.

#### Fried Shrimp Dinner \$16

8 pieces of fried shrimp. Served with Jo-Jo wedge potatoes, homemade hot sauce rice, tangy vinegar coleslaw, and cocktail sauce.

#### Pierogi Dinner \$14

Homemade dumplings filled with fresh mashed potatoes and cheese, topped with butter and onions. **You get 6 pierogi served with a side of sour cream, green beans, applesauce.**

#### Side of Halushki \$5

Dumplings with cabbage and onions sautéed in butter.

#### Tomato and Rice Soup (Pint) \$5

Homemade tomato soup with rice, onion and a hint of garlic. Heat and eat.

#### Baba Vera's Bread Pudding Dessert \$5

Buttery old-fashioned bread pudding dessert full of raisins, vanilla and cinnamon flavors. Topped with a sweet cream sauce. Just like Baba used to make.
